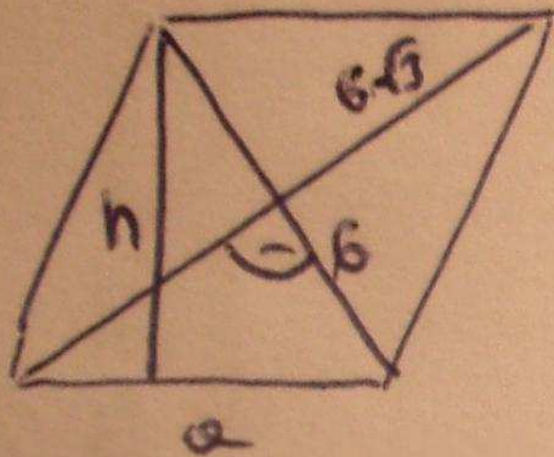




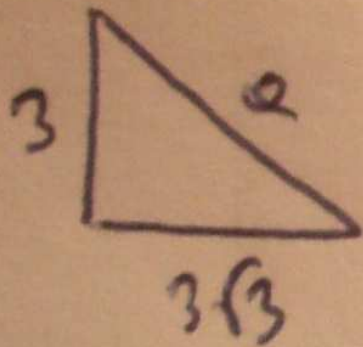
$$P_{\square} = \frac{1}{2} \cdot 6 \cdot 6\sqrt{3} = 18\sqrt{3}$$

$$P_{\square} = q \cdot h$$

$$18\sqrt{3} = q \cdot h$$

$$18\sqrt{3} = 6 \cdot h \quad : 6$$

$$h = \frac{18\sqrt{3}}{6} = 3\sqrt{3}$$



$$q^2 = 3^2 + (3\sqrt{3})^2$$

$$q^2 = 9 + 27$$

$$q = \sqrt{36} = 6$$

$$Obv = 4q = 4 \cdot 6 = 24$$
